GENERAL CLASS INFORMATION

Class sizes are small, allowing for individualized attention. Students have FUN and develop new techniques in the art of creating. Some classes are offered repeatedly because they represent a foundation for making art. Students are invited to take favorite classes multiple times to further develop ideas and techniques.

We employ innovative **art educators** and practicing artists who thrive on nurturing aspiring artists.

Our **facility** offers two studios with ample natural lighting, and includes many artist supplies. For more information or a tour of our facilities please call (920) 733-4089.

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. The maximum class size is ten students and the minimum is four students, unless otherwise indicated. It is necessary to pay for classes in advance to reserve your position for enrollment.

Registration may be made online, in person, by phone, or by mail. Registration forms must be submitted with the class fee at least three business days prior to the class.

Payment is discounted for Trout Museum members. Membership information can be found online. Classes may be paid for with cash, check, Visa or Master Card. Checks should be payable to: The Trout Museum of Art.

Cancellations will be made three business days prior to the class. Students/parents will be notified of cancellation by phone, and refunded the entire class fee.

Withdrawal from a class must be made three business days prior to the first class. There is a \$5 processing fee for all withdrawals. Tuition is nonrefundable if withdrawal is made within the three days prior to the first class.
